COMMENTS/OPERATIONAL NOTES: Grooming this morning in Whitaker Woods including; Bancroft, Whitaker, Fuller, Schuss Flats, Gradual, Lucy, Wellinghurst, Cranmore, Powerline, Vista, Upper Schuss & Cranmore. Powerline is groomed out to the 1785 road crossing and the Stonehurst Manor. Grooming this morning on Intervale network trails including; 1785, Intervale and Lower East Branch trails. Hayfield and Pasture trails will not be groomed today.

The Fat Tire Bike Loop only is open to Fat Tire riders with a trail pass today.
