COMMENTS/OPERATIONAL NOTES: Grooming today on select trails in Whitaker Woods and north to the 1785 road crossing and the Stonehurst Manor. All trails are skate groomed with most trails set with single tracks. Trails open and groomed in Whitaker Woods include; Bancroft, Whitaker, Fuller, Gradual, Cranmore, Powerline, Vista, Armstrong, & Lower Perimeter. Lucy Traverse is closed due to bare sections. Powerline Trail has been groomed north to the 1785 and Stonehurt Trail groomed to the Manor. Trails north of the 1785 Inn remain closed.

All trails in Whitaker Woods are open to fat tire bikes this weekend.
